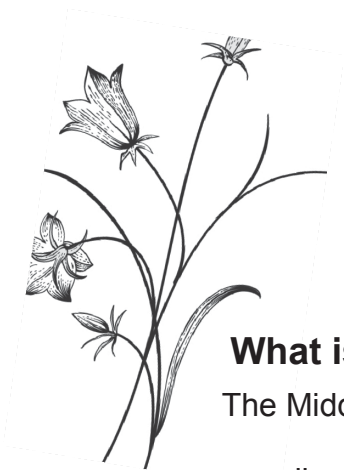

What is the Middlesex Conservation District, and what does it do?

The Middlesex Conservation District (MCD) is one of more than 3,000 United States Conservation Districts established after the Dust Bowl to address soil and water conservation at the local level. Run by a locally elected board of volunteer supervisors, the District is committed to help all landowners in Middlesex County address natural resource concerns through partnerships with federal, state, and local agencies.

MCD is funded through grants, plant sales and workshops. Programs include workshops, outdoor activities about conservation issues, and connections to technical assistance and funding opportunities for landowners (farmers, land trusts, municipalities, and homeowners). MCD provides free learning resources, including soil maps. When funds are available, MCD may also perform pilot projects in conservation.
